5x5x5 - Design Show & Tell

Call for Entries

Objective:

To encourage local firms to “Show & Tell” work that covers all types and areas of architecture, the Spokane Chapter of the American Institute of Architects announces its **5x5x5 - Design Show & Tell** event that will take place at this year’s **2019 Student Design Awards** on the evening of Thursday, April 25, 2019 at the Montvale Event Center. (See *AIA Spokane Chapter website for event details.*)

During this event, 5 projects will be shown, and each participant will have 5 minutes to present 5 PowerPoint slides that best depict their project. In addition to the project presentation, during the event, the work submitted by the firms will also be on display for public viewing.

Through this event, the Chapter seeks to give the opportunity to present/showcase works of distinction and to bring public attention to outstanding architectural services rendered by its members.

Jury Criteria:

Each entry will be judged for the success with which the project has met its individual requirements. Entries will be weighed individually, not in competition with each other. The size and location of the project will in no way limit its eligibility. Each firm is limited to submitting a Maximum of one (1) project for consideration. Jury considerations include design quality, functional utility, economy, environmental harmony, sustainability, aesthetic delight, creativity, craftsmanship, and innovation. **The Jury is limited to selecting a total of five (5) projects for this program.**

The Jury uses submitted written and visual material for their analysis. It is imperative that this information describes the project as clearly and accurately as possible. Submissions are to conform to the standards listed below.

Eligibility:

Built projects as well as unbuilt projects at any stage in the design process are acceptable. An entry must have been designed by either an AIA Member or AIA Associate Member who is a current member of AIA Spokane. For projects in which an AIA Spokane member has joint ventured or retained a design consultant, the AIA Spokane member must be the Architect-of-Record. Entries not meeting these criteria will be disqualified from the **5x5x5 - Design Show & Tell** program. Where responsibility for a project is shared, all participants who substantially contributed to the work must be credited.

The Jury:

Juror selection is based upon the desire to locate impartial individuals who represent high levels of achievement, design quality, professional integrity and regional awareness. Every attempt is made to create a balanced panel that will provide fair judgement to all entries. The jury will be represented at the **5x5x5 - Design Show & Tell** program.

Submittal Guidelines:

- A. Submission Deadline
 - 1. Registration form, PowerPoint, and Images (described below) shall be emailed to:

If files are too large to send on one email, please send them in separate emails (maximum of 3).

- C. PowerPoint
 - 1. Create a PowerPoint using only 5 slides.
 - 2. Each slide may include the desired photos and text needed to describe the project.

- D. Images
 - 1. All images that were included in the PowerPoint are to be emailed separately to:

- E. Printed Materials
 - 1. AIA Spokane will be responsible for printing and displaying work at the 2019 Student Design Awards.

- F. Selected Projects Announced
 - 1. An email will be sent out Wednesday, April 17, 2019, no later than 5 p.m. to all participants notifying them of the 5 projects that were selected by the Jury
